

tread lightly!®

Did you know that Ozarks Jeepthing is a part of Tread Lightly!? "What is that?", you may ask. Tread Lightly! is a national nonprofit organization designed to bring awareness to trails and to preserve them for future generations. By following the guidelines below, we can continue to enjoy the outdoors and also help maintain a healthy environment. Here are some tips:

Avoid Sensitive Areas

- Meadows, lakeshores, wetlands, and streams. All of these areas may have sensitive habitats that could be destroyed by vehicle traffic.
- Do Your Part
 - Dispose of waste, minimize use of fire, restore degrading areas.
 - Pack out what you pack in and keep a bag on your vehicle for litter left by others.
 - Educate Yourself
 - Make a plan tell someone & stick to it.
 - Obtain and reference travel maps and local regulations. Contact land manager for area restrictions and permit requirements.
 - Have a backpack with emergency equipment. Be prepared with tools, supplies, spares and spill kit for trailside repairs.

• Travel Responsibly

- Only drive or ride on roads, trails and other areas open to your mode of transportation.
- Avoid tire spinning, which can gauge the trail.
- Drive over, not around, obstacles to avoid widening the trail.
- Cross streams only at designated fording points where the trail intersects the stream
- Respect the Rights of Others
 - Always ask for permission from landowners when traveling on private property, and leave gates as you find them.
 - Yield the right of way to those passing you or those traveling uphill.
