in our area”**

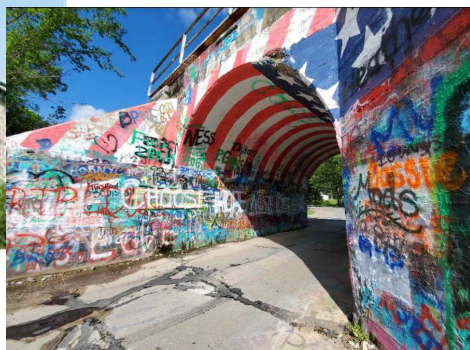
